Participants will engage in strategies and activities that relate their environment to the NC State Education Standards as well as meet the SACERS-U requirements.

Through discussion, group activities and Q&A, participants will be able to use the SACERS-U tool to improve their school age program environment by locating resources, additional notes for clarification, analyzing and scoring activities, identifying low scoring items and explaining the interview process.
