

- Begin your search for childcare early in your pregnancy.
- Increase your chances of enrolling in quality childcare by adding your name to multiple waiting lists.
- When visiting facilities, be observant and ask questions. Carefully listen to the answers.
- Use the website https://ncchildcare.ncdhhs.gov/ to verify information and look at star ratings for childcare providers.



Quality Childcare Checklist

- Are caregivers trained in CPR and First-Aid?
- Do the caregivers have NC Child Care Credentials?
- Is the program licensed?
- Are caregivers willing to answer your questions?
- Are there enough staff members to serve every child?
- Will caregivers tell you what your child is doing everyday?
- Are the children's needs quickly met?
- Are activities developmentally appropriate for the age group?
- Do you agree with the discipline practices?

Home Safety Tips

- Cover all unused electrical outlets.
- Place gates at top and bottom of stairs.
- Lock all potential poisons (cleaners, polishes, lighter fluid, soaps, medicines, etc.) in cabinets.
- Store knives and electrical appliances out of reach.
- Test bath water temperature before putting a child into the bath.
- Supervise children while in the bath.
- Turn pot handles away from the stove.
- Charge batteries in smoke detectors and check regularly.

Birth → 1½ Months	 Expresses different needs with different cries Focuses on high contrast objects Sucks efficiently Lifts head briefly while on tummy Turns heads in the direction of your voice Makes simple sounds like "eh" Briefly makes eye contact with others
2 Months	 Calms down when spoken to or picked up Looks at your face
4 Months	 Smiles on their own to get your attention Looks at you, moves, or makes sounds to get or keep your attention
6 Months	Knows familiar peopleLaughs
9 Months	 Is shy, clingy, or fearful around strangers Shows several facial expressions, like happy, sad, angry, and surprised Reacts when you leave
1 Year	Plays games with you like pat-a-cake
15 Months	 Copies other children while playing, like taking toys out of a container when another child does Claps when excited Shows you affection

18 Months	 Moves away from you, but looks to make sure you are close by Points to show you something Puts hands out for you to wash them
2 Years	 Notices when others are hurt or upset, like pausing or looking sad when someone is crying Looks at your face to see how to react in a new situation
30 Months	 Plays next to other children and sometimes plays with them Follow simple rules when told, like helping to pick up toys when you say "it's clean up time"
3 Years	 Calms down within 10 minutes after you leave, like at childcare drop off Notices other children and joins them to play
4 Years	 Pretends to be something else during play (teacher, superhero, dog) Comforts others who are hurt or sad, like hugging a crying friend Avoids danger, like not jumping from tall heights at the playground Changes behavior based on where they are (a place of worship, library, playground)
5 Years	 Follows rules or takes turns when playing games with other children Sings, dances, or acts for you Does simple chores at home, like matching socks or clearing the table after eating

Language and Communication Milestones

Birth → 1½ Months	 Turns head to the sounds of caregiver's voice
2 Months	Makes sounds other than cryingReacts to loud sounds
4 Months	Makes sounds like "oooo", "aahh"
6 Months	Takes turns making sounds with youMakes squealing noises
9 Months	 Makes a lot of different sounds like "mamamama" and "bababababa" Lifts arms to be picked up
1 Year	 Calls a parent "mama" or "dada" or another special name Understands "no" (pauses briefly or stops when you say it)
15 Months	 Tries to say one or two words besides "mama" or "dada", like "ba" for ball or "da" for dog Looks at a familiar object when you name it Follows directions given with both a gesture and words (for example, he gives you a toy when you hold out your hand and say, "Give me the toy.")
18 Months	 Tries to say three or more words besides "mama" or "dada" Follows one-step directions without any gestures, like giving you the toy when you say, "Give it to me."

2 Years	 Points to things in a book when you ask questions like, "Where is the bear?" Uses more gestures than just waving and pointing, like blowing a kiss or nodding yes
30 Months	 Says about 50 words Names things in a book when you point and ask, "What is this?"
3 Years	 Talks with you in conversation using at least two back-and-forth exchanges Says what action is happening in a picture or book when asked like "running", "eating", or "playing"
4 Years	 Says sentences with four or more words Says some words from a song, story, or nursery rhymes Talks about at least one thing that happened during his day like "I played soccer." Answers simple questions like "Why do we wear a coat?" or "What do we do with a crayon?"
5 Years	 Tells a story she heard or made up with at least two events (for example, a cat was stuck in a tree and a firefighter saved it) Keeps a conversation going with more than three back-and-forth exchanges Uses or recognizes simple rhymes (batcat, ball-tall)

Cognitive Milestones

Birth → 1½ Months	 Stares at high contrast colors and patterns Looks at surroundings briefly
	 Looks at faces Slowly follows a close-range, moving object or person with eyes
2 Months	Watches you as you moveLooks at a toy for several seconds
4 Months	 If hungry, opens mouth when seeing breasts or bottle Looks at hands with interest
6 Months	 Puts things in their mouth to explore them Closes lips to show that they do not want any more food
9 Months	 Looks for objects when dropped out of sight (like a spoon or toy) Bangs two things together
1 Year	 Puts something in a container, like a block in a cup Looks for things they see you hide, like a toy under a blanket
15 Months	 Tries to use things the right way, like a phone, cup, or book Stacks at least two small objects like blocks
18 Months	 Copies you doing chores, like sweeping with a broom Plays with toys in a simple way, like pushing a toy car

2 Years	 Holds something in one hand while using the other hand (for example, holding a container and taking the lid off) Plays with more than one toy at the same time, like putting toy food on a toy plate
30 Months	 Uses things to pretend, like feeding a block to a doll as if it were food Shows simple problem-solving skills, like standing on a small stool to reach something
3 Years	 Draws a circle when you show them how Avoids touching hot objects, like a stove, when you warn them
4 Years	 Tells what comes next in a well- known story Draws a person with three or more body parts
5 Years	 Counts to 10 Names some numbers between 1 and 5 when you point to them Uses words like "yesterday", "tomorrow", "morning", or "night" Pays attention for 5 to 10 minutes during activities (for example, during story time or making arts and crafts - screen time does not count) Writes some letters in their name Names some letters when you point to them

Movement and Physical Milestones

Birth → 1½ Months	 Lifts head briefly when lying on tummy Sucks to eat as well as for comfort Movements are largely controlled by reflexes
2 Months	Holds up head when on tummyMoves both arms and both legs
4 Months	 Holds head steady without support when you are holding them Holds a toy when you put it in their hand Pushes up onto elbows/forearms when on tummy
6 Months	 Rolls from tummy to back Pushes up with straight arms when on tummy
9 Months	 Moves things from one hand to their other hand Sits without support
1 Year	 Walks, holding on to furniture Drinks from a cup without a lid, as you hold it
15 Months	 Takes a few steps on their own Uses fingers to feed themselves
18 Months	 Walks without holding on to anyone or anything Tries to use a spoon

2 Years	 Kicks a ball Walks (not climbs) up a few stairs with or without help Eats with a spoon
30 Months	 Uses hands to twist things, like turning door knobs or unscrewing lids Takes some clothes off by themselves, like loose pants or an open jacket
3 Years	 Strings items together, like large beads or macaroni Uses a fork
4 Years	 Catches a large ball most of the time Serves themselves food or pours water, with adult supervision Unbuttons some buttons Holds crayon or pencil between fingers and thumb (not a fist)
5 Years	Buttons some buttonsHops on one foot
