## Services and Programs for Children Birth to Five and Their Families

**Adolescent Parenting Program (APP)** - A program for teens, 19 or younger, who are pregnant or parenting, and attending school. APP provides support to these teens through intensive home visiting (PAT) and peer group education.

**Buckle Up Kids Beaufort County** - Beaufort County's involvement with a national "Safe Kids" initiative to provide education to parents/primary caregivers on the proper child safety seat needed for their child's age/height/weight. First-time participants who meet eligibility requirements may qualify for a child safety seat at a reduced rate and will receive child passenger safety installation training as the seat is installed. Already installed child safety seats (car carriers, convertible car seats, and booster seats) can also be checked by a trained technician to ensure they are installed correctly.

**Dolly Parton's Imagination Library (DPIL)** - A free book program for children from birth until their fifth birthday. Children receive an age-appropriate book in the mail every month along with tips for families to enhance the reading aloud experience.

**Facilitated Playgroup** - Kaleidoscope Play and Learn is a free, weekly educationally-supportive experience for children birth to five years along with their parents and caregivers. We share stories and songs, create art, and have fun with our friends. During special circumstances, we offer experiences virtually and in-person. **Parents as Teachers (PAT)** - An evidence-based home visiting program for parents of children from the prenatal stage to kindergarten. PAT builds strong communities, thriving families, and children who are healthy, safe, and ready to learn.

**Resource Library** - A twist on the public library, our resource library offers a variety of developmentally appropriate toys, books, and early educator resource materials designed to help parents and caregivers maximize their child's development from infancy through age five.

**Triple P** - From toddler tantrums to bedtime dramas, Triple P helps parents through the big and small issues of parenting. Triple P gives parents skills to manage misbehavior and prevent problems from happening in the first place.
